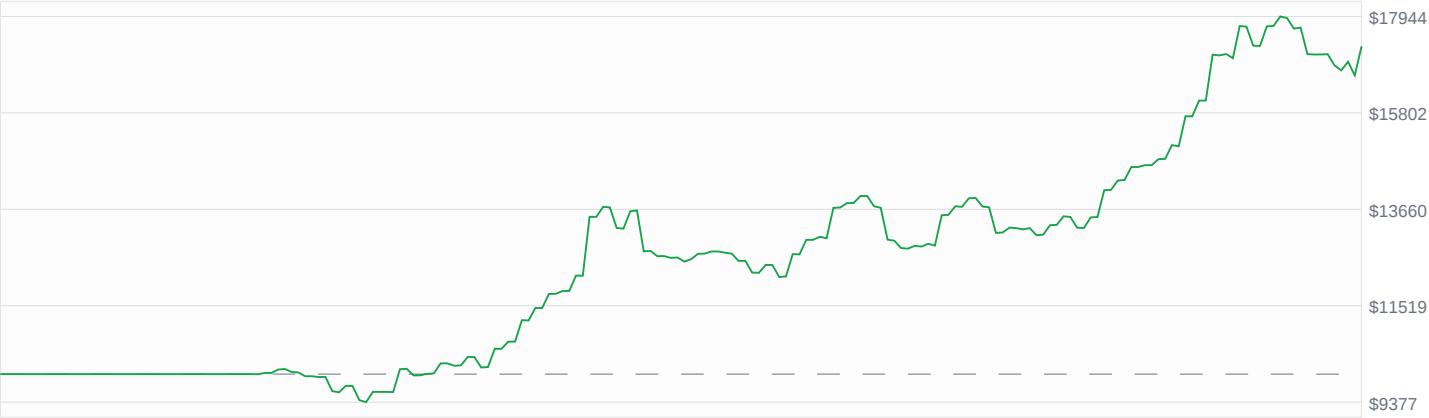

ANALYST NOTE

The Zen Mean Reversion strategy on NSIT generated a +72.76% ROI with an impressive 2.58 Sharpe ratio, yet the 50% win rate and only two total trades reveal a sample size too small for statistical significance. While the limited drawdown of 8.69% suggests controlled risk, the lack of trade frequency indicates the auto-reversion logic is either too conservative or misaligned with current volatility. Relying on this performance for live deployment is premature due to the high variance inherent in such a sparse dataset. The next critical step is to expand the backtest window to at least 100 trades to validate if the alpha persists across different market regimes.
